Application to Pensacola State College

- While completing the Scholarship Application online, you will be asked to list references and their email address for letters of recommendation. If you submit the scholarship application without adding the references, you will NOT be able to log back in and add references later.

FASFA

- Scholarship applicants are encouraged to submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov and list PSC's school code (001513), so that the results will be sent to the Pensacola State College Financial Aid Office.

APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS AT PSC

BEFORE APPLYING:

- Students must first have a PSC Student ID # to complete the scholarship application.

THE APPLICATION:

- The application is completely online and can be found here:

- Students will submit one application which will match them to all PSC scholarships that they qualify for.

- The scholarship application only needs to be submitted once per academic year. (For example, a student who submitted their application in the Fall would not need to resubmit for the Spring semester.)
- Students will be notified of their awards via PirateMail.

 - PSC Scholarship Application is Already Open
 - Summer Semester 2022
 - PSC Scholarship Application Due April 11, 2022 11:59 PM
- 2022 – 2023 Academic Year
 - PSC Scholarship Application Opens March 28, 2022
 - Fall Semester 2022
 - PSC Scholarship Application Due April 22, 2022 11:59PM (first priority deadline – students must submit by this date to maximize their chance of receiving scholarships)
 - PSC Scholarship Application Due July 1, 2022 11:59PM (second priority deadline – last chance to apply for scholarships for the Fall term)



THERESA GAIL MAY SCHOLARSHIP

HISTORY: Theresa Gail May was a social studies teacher at Milton High School. After battling cancer, she passed away in 1986 at the age of 38. In 1996, a foundation was created in her name to award scholarships to students in Santa Rosa County

AWARD AMOUNT: \$4,000 per recipient (unused funds carry over to the following semesters)

CRITERIA:

- Student should demonstrate a financial need.
- Student must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Student must be enrolled full-time or part-time.
- Student must be a resident of Santa Rosa County and a senior at an eligible school (Gulf Breeze High School, Central High School, Jay High School, Locklin Technical College, Milton High School, Navarre High School, Pace High School, Santa Rosa Adult High School, or Santa Rosa Online Academy).
- Student should possess leadership qualities demonstrated in high school or in the community.

To be considered for this scholarship, you must meet the above criteria and stop by Guidance and place your name on the signup list. Deadline to submit your name is Monday, April 11, 2022.

To: High School Principals, Counselors, and Teachers

Pensacola State College is now accepting applications for the 2022-2023 Presidential Scholarship.

Presidential Scholarships are awarded each year to selected high school graduates planning to enroll as a full-time student in the fall. The scholarship award provides tuition, fees, and books for up to two years provided the student remains in compliance with the scholarship policy.

Candidates for a Presidential Scholarship are graduating high school students who have achieved academic merit throughout their high school years and have demonstrated significant involvement in extracurricular activities and achieved recognition on a variety of levels.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Resident Alien;
- Must be a current high school senior graduating this spring and entering college the following fall;
- Must be an incoming freshman or a dual enrolled student with less than 30 earned college credits; and
- Must have an overall 3.2 high school unweighted GPA.

Please direct your outstanding seniors who are transformational leaders both on and off campus and have demonstrated a love of learning and a commitment to enhancing their communities to the Pensacola State College online scholarship application at www.pensacolastate.edu/financial-aid/ and to the 2022 – 2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>). The deadline for the Presidential Scholarship application is April 22, 2022.
